Dear Lifelong Learner,

I have recently completed **Timewise Traveller**, a history of people and world events for the period 1066-1901. This is <u>not</u> a commercial undertaking, and is on the Net <u>completely free of charge – <u>www.timewisetraveller.co.uk</u>. Please spare a few moments to look at it. It has already been adopted as a resource by U3A UK, and is available to all its branches.</u>

This work is something of a **break-through** in the study of history. It includes not only political history but also – <u>running alongside and in equal depth</u> – the development of all the major disciplines, such as the Visual Arts, Music, Medicine, Literature and the Sciences (each of which can be isolated and put into chronological order). As such I am hopeful that, in addition to History, it would be of interest and value to a number of subjects within your programme.

As you will see, **Timewise Traveller** is easy to read, is well documented and illustrated, and there are no adverts or pop-ups to contend with! It has taken me twelve years to complete and a further two years to put it on the Net, so I do hope that it can be put to good use. Because of its page format, it is best seen on a pc, a laptop, or a large tablet.

Please be assured that this is a genuine undertaking. **TT** is produced on a non-profit basis to meet the requirements of the Copyright Design & Patents Act, UK, of 1988. I am a retired teacher who just wants to show that History is, in fact, a fascinating, awe-inspiring subject – indeed, the mother of all subjects! – not just a list of dates, battles and border amendments!
